1. Objective

In a global society, mutual understanding and acceptance of the diversity of lifestyles and cultures in other countries are crucial. The Hakuho Scheme for a Global Children's Japanese Language Network aims to provide opportunities for Japanese and overseas students to deepen their understanding of each other and to grow into internationally-minded people through intercultural experiences and international exchanges in the Japanese language.

2. Program overview

The Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children ("the Program") is a program open to middle schools outside of Japan that teach a Japanese curriculum. The Program invites students studying Japanese at an overseas school, and an accompanying teacher selected by the school, to Japan to visit a participating Japanese school for international exchanges and intercultural experiences in Japanese with Japanese students of the same age.

(1) Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children

- (a) Program period: Thursday 11 April – Thursday 25 April 2019 (tentative)
- (b) Program content: School visit, cultural and social experiences, exchange events, etc.
(There may be a home stay.)
- (c) Number of schools : Around 10 schools
- (d) Participants per school : 4 students and 1 accompanying teacher (participation of school officials in addition to the 1 accompanying teacher is not permitted)
- (e) Planned support: Return airfares to Japan; departure and airport taxes; Japan visa fee; accommodation, meals and activities (including training and travel) while in Japan; international travelers' insurance

To ensure the success of the program, the teachers who will accompany students to Japan will be invited to Japan in the year prior to the Program for preparatory training (Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers).

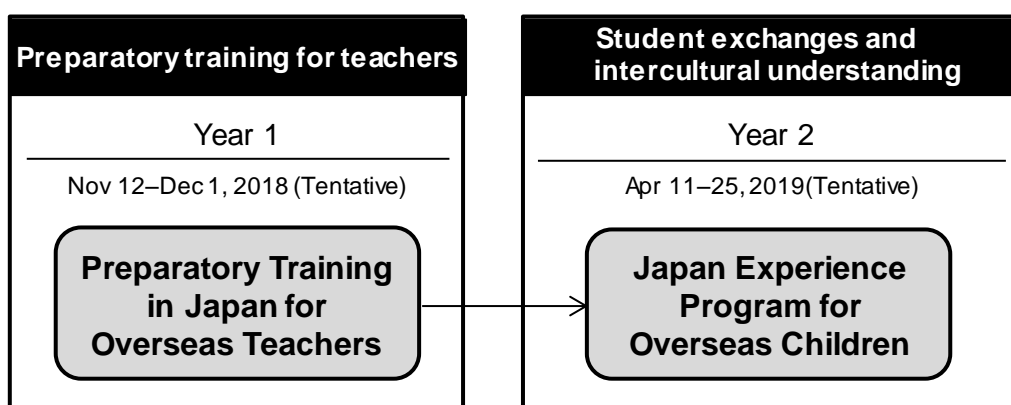
- Teachers who will accompany students from schools selected to participate in the Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children must attend the following Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers.

(2) Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers

Accompanying teachers from schools selected to participate in the Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children come to Japan for training in ways to increase their students' motivation to

study Japanese and prepare for their visit/exchange experiences, and to experience the Program prior to their students' visit.

- (a) Program period: Monday 12 November – Saturday 1 December 2018 (tentative)
- (b) Training content: Ways of helping students to prepare for their visit, experiencing the school visit and Japan cultural and social experiences, etc. that the students will have
- (c) Planned support: Return airfares to Japan; departure and airport taxes; Japan visa fee; accommodation, meals and activities (including training and travel) while in Japan; international travelers' insurance



3. Eligibility

Applications for the Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children are open to schools only.

Applying schools must meet all of the following requirements.

- (1) School must be recognized as a formal middle school-level educational institution by its national government.
- (2) School must be engaged in teaching formal Japanese classes to students between the ages of 12 and 16, the target age of the Program.
- (3) School must be able to obtain any necessary government or other permissions required for participation in the Program and the Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers.
- (4) School must be able to actively and collaboratively prepare for and undertake the Program and Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers if selected.
 - Schools that have participated in the Program previously are eligible to apply.
- (5) School must be able to select and send an accompanying teacher to Japan to participate in both the Program and Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers.
- (6) School must select an accompanying teacher who meets the following requirements:
 - (a) Teacher must be employed by the applying school as a Japanese language teacher until at least the end of the Program.
 - (b) Teacher must be able to participate in both the Program and Preparatory Training in Japan

for Overseas Teachers.

- (c) Teacher must have Japanese ability of at least Japanese-Language Proficiency Test level N3* at the time of application.
- (d) Teacher must not be a graduate of Japan's compulsory education system (incorporating the nine years from elementary school through junior high school).
- (e) Teacher must be physically and mentally fit.

* N3 level: Able to understand Japanese used in everyday situations to some degree.

(7) Schools must have enrolled students that meet the following requirements.

- (a) Aged 12–16
- (b) Have studied Japanese for at least six months at the time of their participation in the Program.

- Even after a school is selected to participate, teachers and students who are found by the Foundation through examination of submitted documents, etc. to not meet the requirements for participation, or who are ineligible for the Hakuho Foundation's nominated international travelers' insurance scheme may be disqualified from participation.

4. Application procedure

(1) Application documents

(a) Participant Application Form

Complete the provided form in the language specified.

Applications that are not completed as specified, or that are submitted without the signature of the principal, will not be considered.

① Part 1 of the Participant Application Form must be signed by hand by the head (principal) of the educational institution.

② Part 3 (3-1/3-2) of the Participant Application Form must be handwritten in Japanese by the selected accompanying teacher.

(b) Japanese ability self-assessment checklist

The selected accompanying teacher should fill in the provided checklist and submit it together with their application.

(c) Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) Certificate of Proficiency

Selected accompanying teachers who have a Certificate of Proficiency from the Japanese Language Proficiency Test are requested to submit a copy of it together with their

application.

(2) Where to obtain the application documents

(3) Application period and address for submission of applications

Application period: Applications must arrive at the designated address between Tuesday 9

January and Friday 9 March 2018

- The designated address for submission of applications is different for each country. Please refer to pages 6 onward for the designated address for submissions in your country.
- Only applications that reach the designated organization by Friday 9 March 2018 will be considered.
- Application documents must be submitted by post. Applications received by fax or email will not be considered.

5. Screening

Applications will be screened rigorously, giving weight to the following, by a judging panel chosen by Hakuho Foundation. The screening criteria and process are confidential.

- (1) Motivations and objectives for participation are clear and in line with the intentions of the Program.
- (2) Positive effects from the exchange can be expected for participating Japanese schools.
- (3) The school and accompanying teacher have applied understanding the objectives of the Program.
- (4) The accompanying teacher has sufficient Japanese language ability to be able to participate in the Program.
- (5) The school is deemed by the judging panel to be suitable for participation in the Program.

6. Notification of results

Applying schools will be notified as to whether they have been selected in June 2018.

Note that we cannot respond to individual inquiries about selection results.

7. Disclosure of information about participating schools

The name and other information about schools selected to participate in the Program will be posted

on the Hakuho Foundation website, etc.

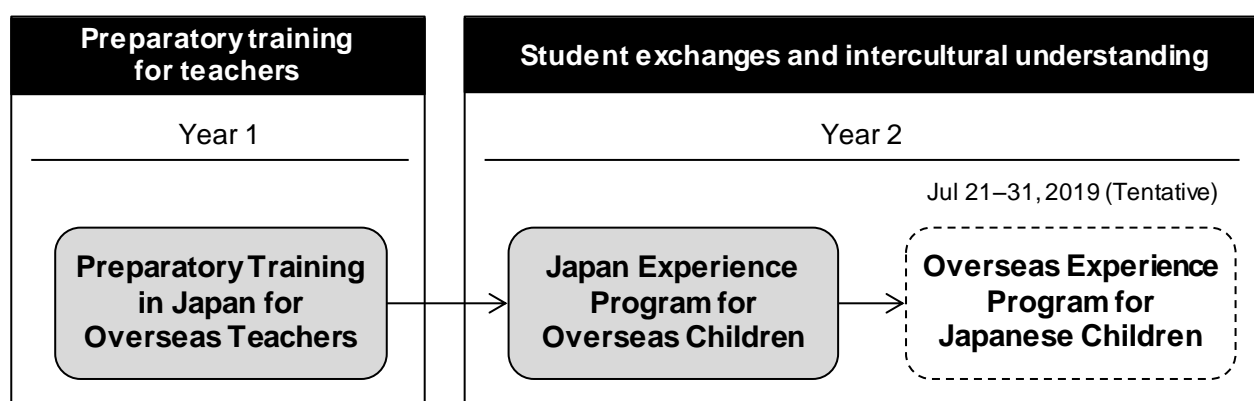
More about the Hakuho Scheme for a Global Children's Japanese Language Network

In addition to the Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children and Preparatory Training in Japan for Overseas Teachers for which we are presently seeking applications from overseas schools, the Scheme also runs an Overseas Experience Program for Japanese Children, in which students from Japanese schools visit overseas schools.

□ Overseas Experience Program for Japanese Children

Japanese students visit an overseas school for international exchanges and intercultural experiences in Japanese with overseas students of the same age. One or two overseas schools participating in the Japan Experience Program for Overseas Children will be invited to become hosting overseas schools.

- (a) Program period: Sunday 21 July – Wednesday 31 July 2019 (Tentative: Actual schedule may vary)
- (b) Program content: School visit, homestay, cultural and social experiences, exchange events, etc.
(You may be asked to host a home stay.)
- (c) Number of Japanese schools: 2 schools (tentative)
- (d) Planned support: Activity expenses (including travel) during the program and other expenses associated with receiving the Japanese schools
